### **Introduction**

Youth Network for Community and Sustainable Development is a movement catalysing social change by engaging young people and amplifying their voices to speak for Human Rights, through targeted advocacy to key players, capacity building and development, communications and media engagements, partnerships and program implementation. We also work on other sexual and reproductive health and rights issues, Governance and Environment.

Over the Years we have been catalysing and galvanizing efforts of young people ending Female Genital Mutilation (FGM), through effective programming that transforms Social Norms that underpin FGM and reproductive health and Rights.

Currently, we are working on curbing unsafe abortion and its consequences in the society through our latest project Enhancing Indicators for Improving Policies and Evidence Gathering Supporting Young People’s Access to Abortion (Project INDIGO). The project is aimed at expanding the cadre of abortion service providers and producing evidence on the consequences of unsafe abortion. This will be done through advocacy, building health workers’ capacity with Values clarifications training and reviewing state policies on medical abortion with focus on Abuja, Lagos and Delta states.

### **Purpose**

YNCSD aims to establish and encourage digital learning via the use of communication materials suited to the needs of an online audience. The aim is to meet the knowledge needs of our stakeholders by having better quality designs and improved visibility through our communication materials.

The video editor will assist in editing several videos and audio materials documenting the work of the project.

### **Responsibilities**

- Ensure delivery of all the end products within deadline
- Able to implement high end video graphic design

- Edit videos as needed to enable communication
- Liaise with Communications Officer and technical team to edit videos
- Provide recommendations on the best video style to adopt
- Video editing (noise reduction, lighting, audio balancing, format exporting). All videos must be of the highest quality standard.
- Video subtitling
- Include appropriate YNCSD branding and credit YNCSD ownership for the produced video

### **Deliverables**

- 5–8 Podcasts ranging between 15–30 minutes over 3 months. Podcasts should be available and ready to be uploaded 2 days before actual date of use for edits and approval.
- 5–6 Pre-recorded Videos ranging between 30–60 minutes over 3 months. Videos should be of high quality and ready to use 3 days before date of actual use, for edits and approval.

### **Desirable Qualities**

- Strong theoretical and practical background in video design, including the use of video editing software
- A demonstrable understanding of the communication requirements of NGOs
- Good understanding of digital platforms
- Working experience in the humanitarian or development sector is desirable

### **Duration**

The period of engagement will be for up to three months starting from May until August 2020.
