

DESIGNING A RESEARCH PROJECT ON ABORTION



Literature Review

Carry out a review on the current situation of abortion in the location of your research to help you strategize accordingly.



Outline the objectives of the research

Outline what the abortion research is aiming to achieve. The answers to your research questions should be able to match the outlined objectives.



Map the target population

Identify the target population whose support you will be needing for your research project and the target population that will benefit from the research project.



Develop Research Modalities

As part of your plan, state clearly how you want to collect data to support your research: quantitative methods, qualitative methods or both, and plan accordingly.



Collecting Data

This can be done through interviews, focus group discussions, questionnaires and surveys, documents and records review, oral histories or observations. Select the most efficient and appropriate method for your research.



Carry out a Complete Analysis of the Data

Make the collated data presentable. Summarize the responses gathered and make relevant inferences in line with your research objectives.



Prepare a Complete, Accurate and Readable Report

Present a summary of the research project from background to the analysis of data. Explain whether/how your objectives were met, challenges encountered, achievements, key points and recommendations.
