## WHAT IS FGM?

Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) refers to the partial or total removal of the external female genitalia or other injury to the female genital organs for non-medical reasons.

- A harmful traditional practice.
- A violation of girls' and women's human rights.
- Deeply rooted in myths, control, and patriarchy.

#### **URBAN VS. RURAL DIVIDE**



FGM is more prevalent in rural communities where access to education, health services, and awareness campaigns is limited



Many cutters are traditional birth attendants or older women in the community.

#### **CONSEQUENCES OF FGM**

- Severe bleeding
- Infection or sepsis
- Pain and trauma

- Painful menstruation
- Complications during childbirth
- Loss of sexual pleasure
- Anxiety, PTSD, and depression

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- FGM prevents promiscuity
- FGM is a religious requirement
- FGM is necessary for marriageability





- FGM has no effect on morality or behaviour.
- No holy book mandates FGM.
- FGM causes pain and trauma, not suitability for marriage.

#### WHAT THE LAW SAYS

The Violence Against Persons Prohibition (VAPP) Act 2015 criminalises FGM in Nigeria.



Up to 4 years in prison or a \$\frac{1}{2}00,000 fine or both.





The VAPP Act only applies in states that have domesticated it. As of 2024, only 30 states have passed the VAPP Law.
